9th Annual Food Pantry Drive

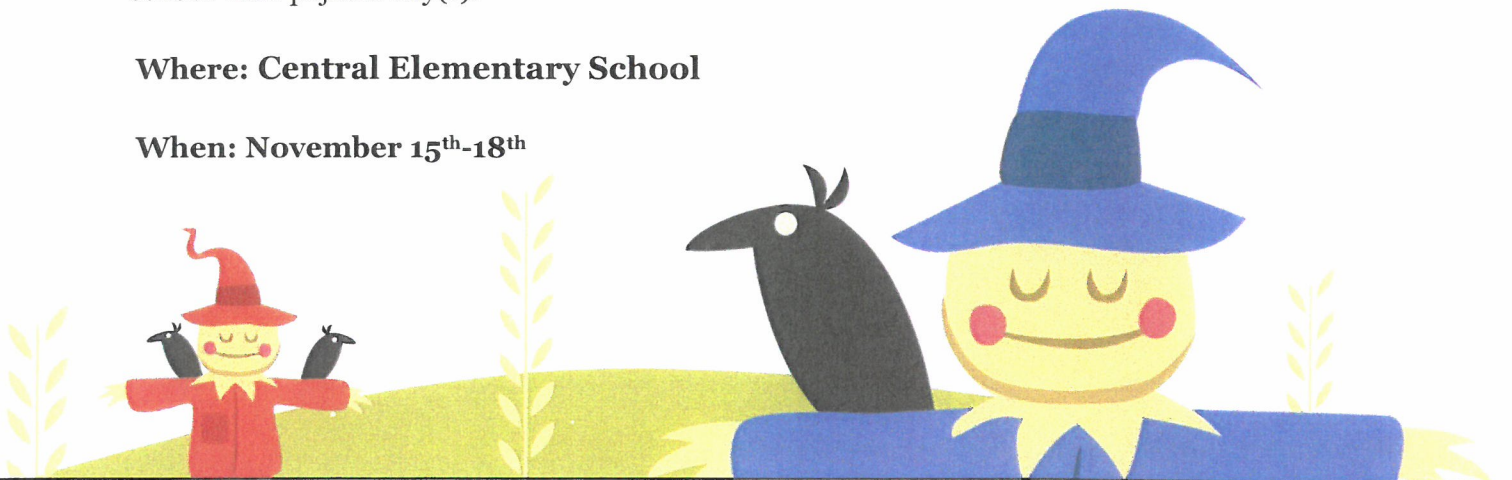
How does it work? The East Bridgewater Food Pantries have a great need for certain kinds of items.
